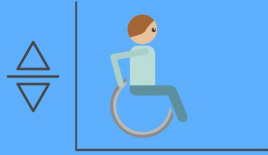


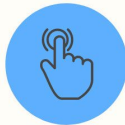
# Safety Features to Look for when Buying a Wheelchair Lift



Safety features are an important factor to consider when buying a wheelchair lift. Top models come with several safety mechanisms that keep the user safe as the device moves between the levels of a building.

## Overspeed governor

Automatically controls the speed and apply the brake, if the device operates beyond a specific speed level.



## Emergency stop button

Located on the platform sidewall, this button can be pressed (in case of any emergency or if any obstructions occur) to stop the lift platform without any sudden jerking movements. An alarm will sound when the button is pressed.

## Non-skid platform

This helps prevent the wheelchair from slipping.



## Sensor system on the platform

Sensors will automatically detect an obstruction in the lift's path.



## Self-lowering ramp

The self-lowering ramp allows the user to move effortlessly from platform to entryway.



## Electro-mechanical interlock

This interlock system prevents accidental opening of the platform gate.

## Battery backup system



This ensures continuous and normal function of wheelchair lift even when the power is off. With battery backup, users don't have worry about getting stuck in between, even when the power is off.

## Auto-folding platform ramp



This feature allows the lift platform to be folded when not in use and leaves the stairway free for other users.

Before purchasing a wheelchair lift, make sure that it has all the required safety mechanism. Read the manufacturer's safety instructions as well before using the device.
